CAMPING FOR EVENTS

PROCEDURE and RULES

I. Motorized Camping by EMMR Members

Motorized camping is defined as overnight camping in or near the vehicle where the vehicle continues to be used for storage or transportation and is permitted as follows:

Event	Camping Starts	Camping Ceases
Latimore Valley Fair	Seven (7) days before the official start of the event	No later than three (3) days after the official end of the event
One (1) Day Events	One (1) day before the official start of the event	No later than one (1) day after the official end of the event
<i>Camping is restricted to the hilltop area in immediate proximity to the Museum</i>		
Two (2) Day Events	Two (2) days before the official start of the event	No later than two (2) days after the official end of the event

II. Procedures for Requesting Permission to Camp for Events

- a. All requests shall be made by emailing EMMR at camping@emmr.org or by calling the Museum phone at 717-528-8279. Please leave a message and your request will be forwarded to the Camping Coordinator.
- b. The current camping fee is \$25/event, which must be paid to obtain a camping permit. Once received, the camping permit shall be displayed in a manner so that the permit is easily visible.
- c. Camping permits can also be obtained from the Museum Gift Shop when open.
- d. A camping permit will not be issued to anyone under the age of eighteen (18) regardless of EMMR membership.

III. Rules for Camping

- a. Under no circumstances shall campers construct, place, maintain or keep fences, enclosures, sheds, outbuildings or structures of any type at the Fairgrounds.
- b. With respect to the containment, treatment and removal of human waste from the Fairgrounds, campers shall comply with the appropriate health, sanitary and safety regulations of Latimore Township and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, including the Pennsylvania Clean Streams Law.
- c. Campsites must be kept clean at all times.
- d. Respect other campers during your stay.
- e. The WGOT/EMMR have adopted a "carry in, carry out" policy with respect to motorized camping at the Fairgrounds. Therefore, all trash and refuse must be carried out.
- f. Cutting, picking, digging, damaging or removing living or dead plant material is prohibited.
- g. Use of camp stoves or grills (including gas grills) is encouraged. Charcoal fires are permitted in appliances designed for them, provided the user disposes of the hot charcoal at a facility designed for charcoal disposal.
- h. Campfires are permitted inside a non-combustible fire ring that is constructed to be less than two (2) feet in diameter. Fires must be attended at all times. Campfires must be put OUT COLD. Campers are not permitted to light campfires when the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Bureau of Forestry, the County of Adams, or the Township of Latimore has determined that the fire danger for Pennsylvania State Forests is

high, very high or extreme, or has otherwise adopted a “burn ban”. Campers assume liability for damages and fines, and they can face criminal charges if they cause a wildfire.

- i. Only downed and dead wood within the immediate campsite may be gathered for firewood. Power saws are not permitted at the Fairgrounds.
- j. Campers are allowed to bring firewood to the Fairgrounds and take firewood with them when they leave the Fairgrounds.
- k. Campers are not allowed to feed wildlife.
- l. Pets must be kept quiet and on a leash at all times. Pet owners are responsible for picking up and properly disposing of pet waste.
- m. All food and trash must be securely stored. Campers must dispose of food particles in trash bins, and not in sink drains or toilets.
- n. Possessing, selling or consuming alcohol, of any type, at the Fairgrounds is prohibited.
- o. Township ordinance requires quiet time from 10 pm until 7 am. Violators will be asked to leave.
- p. No wheeled vehicle will be allowed after dark without head and taillights.
- q. No generators are to be used after 10 pm unless MEDICALLY NECESSARY. Generators must be quiet. Generators are to be utilized intermittently during daylight hours.
- r. Please observe the 5-mph speed limit and follow the traffic direction signs.
